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
Chairman Hood:

Advisory Neighborhood Commission 1B, at its regularly scheduled, publicly noticed May 1 public meeting, with a quorum of 9 of 11 present, considered the redevelopment plan for the McMillan Sand Filtration Site. The Commission voted 8-0-1 to defer to and participate in the process established by ANC 5E, the commission of primary jurisdiction, to gather input from the community and adjacent ANCs and issue recommendations.

Additionally, the Commission voted unanimously to appoint Commissioner E. Gail Anderson Holness to represent the Commission on the McMillian Advisory Group (MAG).
