Re: Z.C. Case No. 16-02 – Applicant's Supplemental Submission

Dear Chairman Hood and Members of the Commission:

The above-referenced case was rescheduled for a public hearing on November 29, 2016 so that the Applicant could update its plans as a result with a compromise with nearby property owners who applied for party status in opposition. This letter and the attached plans supplement and replace, where indicated, those previously filed with the Commission.

## 1. Updated Comprehensive Transportation Review (CTR)

The Applicant updated its CTR to account for the realigned 1<sup>st</sup> Street and retail corridor (see below). The updated analysis is included in <u>Exhibit A</u>. Only the attachments (A & B) to the updated CTR that also changed are included. Attachments C to F are unchanged and are already included in the record as Exhibits 19C – 19F.

## 2. <u>Updated Plans</u>

The plans and drawings attached in  $\underline{\text{Exhibit B}}$  (the "Plans") include updates and changes since the pre-hearing submission on October 13, 2016. Changes to the Plans include the following:

• The Applicant adjusted 1<sup>st</sup> Street along the east side of the stadium to allow a retail corridor along it, particularly along the west side of the street. First Street will be a private two lane road with parking on each side between Potomac Avenue and S Street, SW.

- The stadium will include approximately 14,000 square feet of retail attached to its east side along 1<sup>st</sup> Street.
- Additional future retail will be added along the east side of 1<sup>st</sup> Street between 1<sup>st</sup> Street and the Pepco substation (south of S Street).
- The building along the south side of the stadium has been reimagined and reoriented and will include a retail space (approximately 3000 square feet) at its southeast corner. The bike valet will remain at the building's southwest corner.
- The public plaza northeast of the stadium has been completely reimagined and now includes a public park on its east side that will occupy nearly half of the plaza.
  - o The park will be landscaped and terraced to create an inviting experience.
  - o The plaza will include features, such as a speed table, to make a more pleasant pedestrian experience.
  - o Because of the 1<sup>st</sup> Street adjustment, more of the plaza will be west of 1<sup>st</sup> Street.
- The stadium will include a new public entry point at S and 1<sup>st</sup> Streets. The entry point at the corner of T and 2<sup>nd</sup> Streets has been eliminated.

Otherwise, the overall stadium design and materials remain the same.
