As a resident of the Buzzard Point neighborhood, I write to express my support for the proposed new soccer stadium for the D.C. United.


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In sum, this project will enhance our neighborhood by serving as the catalyst that will bring new residents, promote walkability, attract new retailers, and provide needed community benefits.
