I now walk a block to the park from my home on Place Street to enjoy the park with my son. On a given day, we see other people throwing a ball, dancing, playing basketball or tennis, playing on the jungle gym, or having a picnic. Many parents and kids come because it is so close and walking here fits our daily lives. If the park was half-a-mile or more away, we would not be able to enjoy it nearly as often.

The city's new Comprehensive Plan requires a thorough impact assessment -- ensuring that negative impacts on neighborhoods be mitigated. Not only would a giant tower contradict the character of our neighborhood, but it would create an unmitigated destroying of the community that takes place in our park. It would make the neighborhood cold.
