I oppose replacing Bruce Monroe Community Park with a 9-story-plus-penthouse tower. (Case 16-11)

The city's new Comprehensive Plan requires a thorough impact assessment -- ensuring that negative impacts on neighborhoods, transportation, environmental quality, and other issues are assessed and adequately mitigated. The DC Appeals court made clear this was not thoroughly done.

The Bruce Monroe Park is an important community resource, used by a wide range of community members for recreation and as a gathering space. During this ongoing pandemic, open green spaces that allow people to safely recreate and socialize are more essential than ever.
