I am extremely concerned and opposed the proposed development by JBG. The extreme size is totally out of proportion to the area, and would demolish the green spaces. Traffic here is already at a maximum. I can not imagine adding the proposed additional 4000 people envisioned through PUD 1 and 2. Instead, it is important that a Small Area Plan be developed that is more consistent with this neighborhood.
