**Re:** ZC Case 16-23 – Valor Development, LLC – Voluntary Design Review CRD's Response to Valor's Second Deferral Request

Chairman Hood:

On behalf of my client, Citizens for Responsible Development (CRD), I am responding to Valor Development's (the "Applicant" or "Valor") April 16<sup>th</sup> second request for a deferral of the Zoning Commission's (the "Commission") deliberation. This request follows their February 22<sup>nd</sup> deferral request and three previous requests for postponement.

In response to Valor's first request for deferral of the Commission's deliberation on this matter from the scheduled date of February 26, 2018, CRD had requested at least three weeks' time to prepare its responsive submissions. At that time, CRD anticipated any Applicant submissions to be merely supplemental in nature. Valor now proposes to submit an entire redesign of the Ladybird project and so CRD is requesting, at a minimum, 30 days to prepare its responses. We also ask that the record be reopened.

It must be noted that CRD has not objected to the February 22<sup>nd</sup> deferral request nor did CRD object to any of the Applicant's requests to defer the original hearing dates. CRD likewise does not object to the current request, but respectfully requests that the Commission afford it sufficient time to adequately respond to the new design and figures Valor plans to submit by June 18, 2018. On April 20, 2018, CRD consulted Spring Valley Opponents, the other Party in Opposition, and they support the above requests.

We appreciate the Commission's consideration of this matter.
