Greater Washington Community Foundation	The Partnership to End Homelessness Grantmaking Fund is a partnership between the Greater Washington Community Foundation and the District of Columbia Interagency Council on Homelessness to provide support for nonprofit providers in DC to help people obtain and maintain permanent housing and reduce the amount of time spent in the homeless services system. The Partnership invests in nonprofits working with individuals, youth and families experiencing homelessness. It provides flexible funding to fill critical gaps, often small expenses, that can create big barriers to obtaining and maintaining stable housing (e.g., costs for transportation to view units, rental application fees, basic household furnishings, moving expenses, etc.). It also supports innovative programs, emerging needs and advocacy efforts focused on strengthening policies that impact housing and homelessness.	\$75,000
New Endeavors By Women	To purchase computer lab equipment and support programs providing women and families with supportive services and transitional housing at 611 N Street, N.W.	\$20,000
Shaw Main Street	To support the Shaw Main Street's Clean & Safe Team.	\$30,000
Kennedy Recreation Center	To purchase new computers, equipment, and supplies for the technology lab, and to provide general operational support for Kennedy Recreation Center.	\$15,000
Boolean Girl	MidCity will sponsor one year of the nonprofit organization Boolean Girl to operate in the updated computer lab at the Kennedy Recreation Center. Boolean Girl provides a curriculum, equipment, materials and instructors to teach coding to disadvantaged children. The program can serve 75 children over the course of one year, and participants will be recruited from the Shaw neighborhood.	\$15,000
DC Public Library Foundation (fbo Shaw Neighborhood Library) (Watha T. Daniel)	To support improvements to the children's section and related programming at the Shaw Library.	\$20,000
