The Office of Zoning has received and reviewed the request for the petition cited above, which requests:

Review and approval of a map amendment for properties in the northeast quadrant in the District that are approximately bounded by H Place, N.E. and midblock Square 4495 (north), 21st Street, N.E. (east), Benning Road (south), and 18th Street, N.E. and midblock Square 4507 (west). The petition would rezone from RA-2 to RF-4, various lots in Squares 4494, 4495, 4506, and 4507; and from MU-4 to MU-5 zone, various lots in Squares 4506 and 4507, and Parcels 160/38 (southern portion) and 160/22.

The Office of Zoning has determined that your petition is complete, that it meets the basic filing requirements, and that the appropriate filing fee has been paid. This petition has therefore been accepted for processing.

The Office of Planning (OP) will further process this petition prior to it being presented to the Zoning Commission. The initial consideration given to the petition concerns whether the Commission should set the case down for a public hearing.
