Advisory Neighborhood Commission (ANC) 1B considered the matter of ZC case 20-08B related to a property at 1901-1911 5th St NW (located in Single Member District 1B01) at its meeting on Thursday April 6. **ANC 1B supports ZC case 20-08B at 1901-1911 5th St NW, asking for zoning relief.**

ANC 1B considered the request by Howard University for zoning relief for university use (administrative and office use) of that property for a fixed term of five years. ANC 1B acknowledges that Howard University may re-apply for further zoning relief at that time.

After considering the matter, ANC 1B voted (8 in favor, 0 against, 0 abstaining) to “*send a letter to the Zoning Committee in support of zoning case 20-08B for zoning relief.*” This letter constitutes the execution of ANC 1B’s action.


