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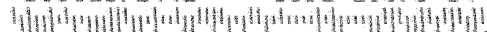
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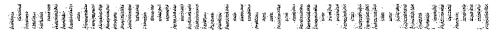

The Trustees for Harvard University (the “Harvard”) filed an application (the “Application”) on June 27, 2023, requesting:

- (i) approval of an amendment to the 2020–2040 Campus Plan for the Dumbarton Oaks Research Library and Collection (“Dumbarton Oaks”) (the “Approved Campus Plan”) to replace the new greenhouse identified as Building 7 on the Approved Campus Plan and to relocate and reconfigure the cooling towers, mechanical equipment and service court at the northwest edge of the site; and
- (ii) further processing to construct a new mixed-program building, to be known as the Farrand House, in lieu of the new green house, pursuant to Subtitle X § 101.9 (Title 11 of the District of Columbia Municipal Regulations, Zoning Regulations of 2016, to which all references are made unless otherwise specified (“DCMR”).

Dumbarton Oaks is located at 1703 32nd Street, N.W. (Square 2155, Lot 812) and is generally bounded by Dumbarton Oaks Park on the north, Montrose Park to the east, R and S Streets, N,W. to the south, Jelleff Field and single-family residential uses to the west, and the Wisconsin Avenue corridor to the east. It is located within the R-1-B zone and within the boundaries of Advisory Neighborhood Commission (“ANC”) 2E-07. The proposed new mixed-program building, to be known as the Farrand House, will consist of approximately 10,000 square feet of floor area, and
