- 1. Chris Van Arsdale and Diana Movius have called neighbors attending information sessions "racist" including me when I offered studies that demonstrate some of the problems encountered with urban planning and mixed income level developments.
- 2. Chris Van Arsdale and Diana Movius have both threatened the "homeless shelter" alternative at open meetings and in private meetings with neighbors.
- 3. All virtual meetings held by Chris Van Arsdale and Diana Movius have been muted and anonymous to participants.
- 4. There are 627 affordable units under construction or in the pipeline and 97 units available for rent right now.
- 5. Chris Van Arsdale lives in Maryland and Diana Movius works as an energy consultant and travels a lot. She lives in DC but not along 14th street. Dance Loft has hosted raves, served alcohol without a license and hasn't been a good neighbor to the residents that surround the area. Further Dance Loft is a studio rental operation and doesn't have a serious placement in the cultural arts community of Washington DC. The building is unkempt, not accessible and hasn't been improved in the 10 years that Diana Movius has rented it for her studio rental business.
- 6. The scale model cost \$5000.00 to produce on a 3D printer. Chris Van Arsdale said that he's not able to produce a model because it costs too much.
- 7. There appears to a very chummy relationship between Mr. Campbell(ANC) and Chris Van Arsdale and Diana Movius.
- 8. In my research, graffiti reduces the value of surrounding real estate.
- 9. I believe that one of the unforeseen consequences of the mayor's extreme position on automobile restriction is higher levels of pollution in residential areas that become major thruways because of lack of road infrastructure. More residents equal more pollution.
