On December 2, 2021, the Office of Zoning received an application from the Office of the Attorney General (the "Petitioner") for approval of a text amendment to Subtitle I. The Petitioner is proposing changes to Sections 502.3, 516.2, 531.4, 539.2, 547.3, 555.2, 562.3, and 569.2. The effect of these amendments would be to remove exemptions from Inclusionary Zoning ("IZ") requirements from certain areas within the Downtown ("D") Zones.
