

Exhibit E- Summary of ANC Discussions and Public Space Committee Status

Exhibit 34C details the full history of the Applicant's discussions and meetings with the ANC, as well as changes made to the design based on ANC feedback. Since the filing on May 26, 2022, the Applicant's team and the ANC have had the following meetings:

- June 6th: The Applicant attended ANC 6D's Administrative Meeting.
- July 7th: The Applicant met with the Office of Planning.
- July 25th: The Applicant met with the ANC's Subcommittee.
- August 26th: The Applicant met with the ANC's Subcommittee.
- September 6th: The Applicant attended ANC 6D's Administrative Meeting.
- September 12th: The Applicant attended ANC 6D's Full Meeting.

At the meeting on September 12, the ANC voted to conditionally support the Application conditioned on DDOT-Public Space approving the curb cut and loading area originally shown in Exhibit 2G1- Page 4. This continues to be the main issue for the SMD and Vice-Chair Kramer, although to the Applicant's knowledge, no members have the public have expressed concerns to the Applicant or at any public meetings about this issue.

Given the ANC's concerns, the Applicant applied for a Public Space Permit late August for the curb cut via TOPS and received the following comments, which were relayed to the ANC:

- 1) The curb cut would not be permissible because there is a PEPCO vault on the N Street-side. PEPCO noted that cars and trucks are not permitted to drive over their facility because the facilities are not equipped to handle vehicular loads.
- 2) Washington Gas states noted there is an active gas line on the east side of the project. We will need to coordinate with them as we continue to design the Public Space because we need to maintain separation distances for their facilities.
- 3) DDOT PSRD stated that they do not support the new curb cut due to the introduction of a new vehicular/pedestrian conflict and the back-in loading.

While the Applicant has received clear indication from DDOT-Public Space that a curb cut will not be allowed for a number of reasons, including utility issues involving a Pepco Vault, the Applicant is proceeding with the Public Space hearing on September 22, 2022, so that Ms. Kramer (Vice Chair for ANC) and the SMD, Ms. Hamilton, may attend and speak to their concerns.

The Applicant will continue to work with the ANC regardless of the outcome of the Public Space Committee hearing and continues its commitment to the Agreement proposed in Exhibit 34E.
