Neighbors for a Livable Community (NLC) – Spring Valley-Wesley Heights Citizens Association (SVWHCA) make this motion to request the Commission to reopen the record in the above referenced case to accept the printed copy of oral testimony presented by NLC-SVWHCA at the June 13, 2022 hearing.
