The Office of Zoning has received and reviewed the request for the application cited above, which requests:

Review and approval of a zoning map amendment for property located in the northwest quadrant of the District at Square 449, Lot 64, and also known as 1100 6th Street, N.W.

The Office of Zoning has determined that your application is complete, that it meets the basic filing requirements, and that the appropriate filing fee has been paid. This application has therefore been accepted for processing.

The Office of Planning (OP) will further process this application prior to it being presented to the Zoning Commission. The initial consideration given to the application concerns whether the Commission should set the case down for a public hearing.
