
> Re: Zoning Commission Case 23-02 Hearing Date: January 7, 2024 Public Unable to Sign Up To Testify


## Dear Chair Hood:

I have received complaints today that the Office of Zoning website would not allow people to sign up to testify at tomorrow's hearing. People who tried to sign up on *Sunday morning* and *Sunday afternoon* to testify in Case 23-02 have not been able to do so.

This is clearly wrong since the Office of Zoning website and the Public Notice in this case state the public is allowed to sign up to testify up to 24 hours before the start of the hearing, as Ms. Schellin, Secretary to the Commission, has also previously confirmed. Below is a screenshot one person sent me who had been trying since this morning to sign up to testify. This person also called the phone number shown in the second screenshot but no one answered. There almost assuredly were other members of the public who were denied their right to sign up today to testify in Case 23-02.

Though this appears to be a website malfunction, prematurely cutting off the right of the public to testify in this contested case is a serious problem. Does the Commission not monitor the website to make sure the site is properly functioning? Please see the 2 screenshots below. The first screenshot is the attempt to register at 3:35pm to testify. The second screenshot is the message not allowing the person to register to testify. This person tried repeatedly on Sunday to timely sign up to testify and was denied that right, as others almost certainly were as well.
