Re: Congress Park Community Partners, LLC Map Amendment in Square 5914

Dear Chairman Hood:

At a properly notified and held meeting which took place on June 22, 2021, with a quorum of 5 Commissioners present, Advisory Neighborhood Commission (ANC) 8E voted unanimously to support Congress Park Community Partners' zoning map amendment to rezone the eastern portion of Lot 806 in Square 5914 (known as Parcel B within 1351 Alabama Avenue, SE, Washington, DC) from RA-1 Zone to MU-8 Zone. We learned that this change will add residences to the building without making the building too large or out of place in the neighborhood. As such, we support the expansion.

We believe Congress Park Community Partners' petition will further facilitate the implementation of broad public policy and the District's Comprehensive Plan. This amendment would support the District's Comprehensive Plan by providing medium-density housing and neighborhood-serving retail and service uses in this area.
