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CHAIRPERSON HOOD: Good afternoon, ladies gentlemen. We are convening and broadcasting this public hearing by videoconferencing. Today's date is February 22nd, 2021. Tonight's case is Case No. 19-27B, which consists of the text amendment will not result -- let me say this though, when I was studying this -- I want to make sure the public knows this, that this text amendment in this case we're hearing tonight and others that I will call later, this text amendment will not result in any substantive changes to the affected subtitles. This text amendment will be part of a comprehensive final action in the Zoning Commission Cases 18-16 and 19-27 in the remaining alphabets A and B.

The reorganization will also reflect other text amendments adopted by the Commission including Zoning Commission Cases 19-14 and 19-21. Again, this text amendment will not result in any substantive changes to the affected subtitles.

Today's date again is February 22nd, 2021. My name is Anthony Hood, and joining me are Vice Chair Miller, Commissioner Shapiro, Commissioner May, and Commissioner Turnbull. We're also joined by the Office of Zoning staff, Ms. Sharon Schellin, and Mr. Paul Young, who will be handling all of our virtual operations.

We ask all others to introduce themselves at the

appropriate time. Copies of today's virtual public hearing notice are available on the Office of Zoning's website. Please be advised that this proceeding is being recorded by a court reporter and is also webcast live via Webex and YouTube Live.

The video will be available on the Office of Zoning's website after the hearing. Accordingly, all those listening on Webex or by phone will be muted during the hearing, and those who have signed up to participate or testify will be unmuted at the appropriate time.

Please state your name and home address before providing oral testimony on your presentation. When you are finished speaking, please mute your audio so that your microphone is no longer picking up sound or background noise.

This hearing will be conducted in accordance with provisions of 11Z DCMR Chapter 5 as follows: preliminary matters,

2	report of other government agencies; report of the ANC, this is
3	citywide; testimony of organizations and individuals.
4	Organizations will have five minutes, individuals will have three
5	minutes, respectively. And we will hear in the order from those
6	in support, opposition or undeclared.
7	While the Commission reserves the right to change the
8	time limits for presentations, if necessary, it intends to adhere
9	to the time limits as strictly as possible, and notes that time
10	shall be ceded.

13	At this time the Commission will consider any
14	preliminary matters. Does the staff have any preliminary
15	matters?
16	MS. SCHELLIN: Just to no preliminary matters, just
17	to advise the Commission that as of 10 minutes ago there were no

to advise the Commission that as of 10 minutes ago there were no sign-ups for testimony, and we have Elisa Vitale and Jennifer Steingasser from the Office of Planning to present this evening.

CHAIRPERSON HOOD: Okay. Thank you, Ms. Schellin, that was going to be my next question, did we have anybody signed up? After we hear the presentation, we'll check again, and we'll keep proceeding in that manner.

Let's bring up Ms. Vitale and Ms. Steingasser, I see they're already here. We'll turn it over to you both and you

all may begin.

MS. STEINGASSER: Chairman Hood, Commissioners, thank you. Your introduction covers most of our presentation. This case is the fourth and final on the reorganization of the zoning regulations that started with Case 18-16, which established new zone names.

This particular evening we're focused on Subtitle J which is the production, distribution and repair subtitle and conforming language to the other non-land use -- subtitles, being A, B, C, U, W, X, Y and Z.

Tonight the PDR zones are proposed to reflect the new nomenclature of naming under Case 18-16, which creates a PDR-5, PDR-6 and a PDR-7 -- new names. It also then goes through all the other subtitles and makes appropriate changes to those subtitles to reflect all new zone names.

The Commission has already taken proposed action on those zone names. You have also taken proposed action on similar reorganization of the land use Subtitles D, E, F, G and H. And this will be the final one for Subtitle J.

With that, I'm available for any questions.

CHAIRPERSON HOOD: Okay. Thank you, Ms. Steingasser, I think this motion is pretty straightforward. Let's see if we have any questions or comments. Commissioner May?

COMMISSIONER MAY: No audible answer.

CHAIRPERSON HOOD: Commissioner Shapiro?

1	COMMISSIONER SHAPIRO: No audible answer.
2	CHAIRPERSON HOOD: Commissioner Turnbull?
3	COMMISSIONER TURNBULL: No, I've got (audio
4	interference)
5	CHAIRPERSON HOOD: Vice Chair Miller?
6	VICE CHAIR MILLER: No questions, thank you.
7	CHAIRPERSON HOOD: Thank you. Ms. Steingasser, I'm
8	going to ask this question just in case somebody reviews this
9	tape.
10	MS. STEINGASSER: Okay.
11	CHAIRPERSON HOOD: And I know I stated it and I read
12	it twice, but there are no substantive changes in this proceeding,
13	correct?
14	MS. STEINGASSER: You are correct, Chairman Hood, there
15	are no substantive changes. You've said it now three times and
16	it's also in (audio interference). So, you're absolutely
17	CHAIRPERSON HOOD: Well, three times used to be a charm,
18	but I found out sometimes five and six works.
19	MS. STEINGASSER: I absolutely appreciate you stressing
20	that point.
21	CHAIRPERSON HOOD: Okay. Let me I don't know which
22	one is harder, working the computer and trying to get your files
23	up or okay, let's go to again, we don't have anyone who is
24	waiting to testify, so let's go to any do we have any I
25	didn't see any ANC reports. I think this is pretty

1	straightforward, but I want to call again, Ms. Schellin, do
2	we have anyone who would like to testify in the audience?
3	MS. SCHELLIN: There are no attendees.
4	CHAIRPERSON HOOD: Okay. So noted. Commissioners,
5	anything else? I think we we didn't have any additional
6	reports. I think OAG has worked along with OP with the renumbering
7	and the format and everything, so I think we're pretty
8	straightforward. Let me open it back up to my colleagues, any
9	questions or comments?
10	Okay. So thank you, Ms. Steingasser and Ms. Vitale.
11	What I think we can do now, Commissioners, since it looks like
12	everything is pretty straightforward to move forward, I would
13	move that we approve Zoning Commission Case No. 19-25B (sic),
14	Office of Planning text amendment to Subtitle J, Zoning
15	Reorganizations in Subtitles A-C, U, W-Z and for zoning
16	conformity and ask for a second.
17	VICE CHAIR MILLER: Second.
18	CHAIRPERSON HOOD: Okay. It's been moved and properly
19	seconded, it looks like.
20	Vice Chair Miller, you have any discussion? Okay. It
21	looked like you were puzzled.
22	Commissioner Shapiro?
23	COMMISSIONER SHAPIRO: I just want to make sure; this
24	is proposed action we're taking, Mr. Chair?
25	CHAIRPERSON HOOD: Yes. I think we have to this has

1	to be noticed yeah, this is proposed. So this has to be
2	noticed I don't know if we do NCPC or not. I'm very confused
3	now. Yeah, this is proposed action.
4	COMMISSIONER SHAPIRO: Okay. Thank you. No further
5	discussion on my side.
6	CHAIRPERSON HOOD: Okay. Thank you. And I'll include
7	that this is proposed action in my motion. Vice Chair, would
8	you accept me saying proposed action? I believe you will.
9	VICE CHAIR MILLER: Yes. Yes.
10	CHAIRPERSON HOOD: Okay. All right. All right.
11	Commissioner May?
12	COMMISSIONER MAY: Yeah, I just want to ask, is there
13	anything substantive involved in this change?
14	CHAIRPERSON HOOD: That's what gets us in trouble.
15	COMMISSIONER MAY: Sorry. As long as there's nothing
16	substantive, thank you very much.
17	CHAIRPERSON HOOD: Okay. Thank you for that too,
18	nothing substantive. So, everything tonight was not substantive.
19	Okay. So it's been moved and properly seconded. Any further
20	discussion? Okay. Ms. Schellin, would you do a roll call vote,
21	please?
22	MS. SCHELLIN: Commissioner Hood?
23	CHAIRPERSON HOOD: Yes.
24	MS. SCHELLIN: Commissioner Miller?
25	VICE CHAIR MILLER: Yes.

1	MS. SCHELLIN: Commissioner Turnbull?
2	COMMISSIONER TURNBULL: Yes.
3	MS. SCHELLIN: Commissioner May?
4	COMMISSIONER MAY: Yes.
5	MS. SCHELLIN: Commissioner Shapiro?
6	COMMISSIONER SHAPIRO: Yes.
7	MS. SCHELLIN: The vote is 5 to 0 to 0 to approve
8	proposed action in Zoning Commission Case No. 19-27B. With that,
9	the record will be closed until a notice of proposed rulemaking
10	is published in the DC Register, at which time the record will
11	reopen for a 30-day comment period.
12	CHAIRPERSON HOOD: Okay. Thank you. Anything else,
13	Ms. Schellin?
14	MS. SCHELLIN: No, sir.
15	CHAIRPERSON HOOD: Okay. Commissioners, any closing
16	comments?
17	So with that, our next Zoning Commission's next public
18	meeting is going to be February 25th, this coming Thursday. We
19	have a number of agenda items on the agenda, so. It will start
20	at 4 p.m.
21	So with that, I'm going to thank everyone for their
22	participation tonight. Again, stay safe, and we'll see you on
23	Thursday. This hearing is adjourned.
