Next is Board action on Application No. 20181 of 6 7 Medici Road, as amended, pursuant to Subtitle X, Chapter, for a special exception under Subtitle U, Section 320.2, 8 9 to allow the conversion of an existing residential 10 building to an apartment house, and pursuant to Subtitle X, Chapter 10, for area variances from the minimum lot 11 12 area requirements of Subtitle U, Section 320.2(d) and from the minimum parking space size requirements of Subtitle C 13 14 Section 712.3 to allow a four-unit apartment house in the RF-1 Zone at 1315 Harvard Street, NW, Square 2854, Lot 86. 15 And this case was denied by the Board on January 29, 2020, 16 17 and this item is on the meeting agenda before the Board to take action on issuing the final order. 18 19 BZA CHAIR HILL: Okay, all right. So all the 2.0 parties were sent the proposed order. We've all had an 2.1 opportunity to review the proposed order and we have a 22 quorum now to issue. And so I'd like to make a motion to 23 issue the proposed order and ask for a second. 24 Ms. John? 25 VICE CHAIR JOHN: Second.

22	of Jose Andres Reinoso and Miguelina Zapata, Trustees.
23	This is a request pursuant to Subtitle Y, Section 705.1
24	for a two-year time extension of the validity of the order
25	moving Application No. 20676 which was issued in final on

1	April 26, 2022. This is to permit a child development
2	center in the same two-story semi-detached building that's
3	located in the R-3 zone at 4500 New Hampshire Avenue, NW,
4	Square 3248, Lot 77.
5	BZA CHAIR HILL: Okay. Thank you. I've had a
6	chance to review the order. I'm sorry, the request for
7	the time extension. I would agree with the Applicant's
8	argument as to their inability to secure all required
9	government agency approvals by the expiration date.
10	The Office of Planning is also in favor of this
11	extension and I've read their recommendation and I believe
12	everyone has been notified of this, including the ANC, but
13	we don't have anything from the ANC, so I assume they did
14	not have anything to add.
15	I would be voting in favor of this time
16	extension, but is there anything you would like to add,
17	Mr. Smith?
18	MEMBER SMITH: I have nothing to add, Chairman.
19	BZA CHAIR HILL: Okay. Mr. Blake?
20	MEMBER BLAKE: I'll be in support of the
21	requested time extension.
22	BZA CHAIR HILL: Thank you. Vice Chair John?
23	VICE CHAIR JOHN: Nothing to add, Mr. Chairman.
24	I'm in support.
25	BZA CHAIR HILL: Thank you. Chairman Hood?

3	they asked for, but I hope they've asked for enough time.

MEHLERT: No. Next is Application No. 20184-A of Fort Lincoln-Eastern Avenue, 11 12 This is a request pursuant to Subtitle Y Section 705.1 for a one-year time extension of the Board's order 13 in Application No. 20184 which was issued in final on 14 April 20th, 2022. 15 This is to allow a new residential development of 51 townhouse dwellings in a theoretical lot 16 17 subdivision in the RA-1 and RA-4 zones.
