3 CHAIRPERSON BENNETT: Good evening. My
4 name is Maybelle Taylor Bennett. I'm Chairperson of
5 the District of Columbia Zoning Commission.

6 We are now convening the Special Public
7 Meeting of the 1057th meeting session and the fourth
8 of 1997.

9 I would ask that those who are leaving
10 the room please do so quietly. Those who are
11 leaving the room, please do so quietly.

12 I don't know if there are any
13 preliminary matters.

14 Are there any preliminary matters, Ms.
15 Brown? All right.

16 Why don't we then turn to the order that
17 we have in the packet that was given to us, 95-4I.
18 I'm not sure if it's I or Roman Numeral I. We did
19 have a full Commission to hear this one. Ms. Kress
20 had to step out momentarily, but the three of us can
21 turn our attention to Draft Order Number 806.

22 Colleagues, if you recall, the concern
23 here was that there was no mention made of the
24 testimony offered by the representatives of the
25 Children's Museum. What we had asked was that such
26 reference be made. If you turn to page 2, in the

1 third full paragraph, you'll see a discussion of the
2 Director of Administration for the National Learning
3 Center, Capitol Children's Museum, set forth there.
4 So, I'm pretty satisfied that the staff was able to
5 modify the order as we have asked.

6 Are there any substantive changes?

7 Okay.

8 Is there a motion then?

9 COMMISSIONER FRANKLIN: So moved, Madam
10 Chair.

11 CHAIRPERSON BENNETT: We move approval.
12 Second?

13 COMMISSIONER PARSONS: Second.

14 CHAIRPERSON BENNETT: All right.

15 Further discussion? Hearing none, all
16 those in favor sign by aye?

17 ALL: Aye.

18 CHAIRPERSON BENNETT: Opposed?

19 (No response.)

20 CHAIRPERSON BENNETT: Abstentions?

21 (No response.)

22 CHAIRPERSON BENNETT: The ayes have it.

23 And then finally, the last order of
24 business for the Special Public Meeting has to do
25 with the resolution regarding Mr. William Ensign's
26 service on the Zoning Commission. We have had an

1 opportunity to review it and based on our review,
2 the second paragraph, the seventh and eighth
3 paragraphs have been excised. And all of us have
4 signed. All of those of us who are here have signed
5 it.

6 If that is all right, we should, I
7 think, take a vote on the resolution. Is there a
8 motion?

9 COMMISSIONER PARSONS: So moved that we
10 adopt the resolution as it has been revised.

11 CHAIRPERSON BENNETT: Thank you.

12 Is there a second?

13 COMMISSIONER FRANKLIN: Second.

14 CHAIRPERSON BENNETT: All right. Any
15 further discussion?

16 Hearing none, all those in favor sign by
17 aye?

18 ALL: Aye.

19 CHAIRPERSON BENNETT: Opposed?

20 (No response.)

21 CHAIRPERSON BENNETT: Abstentions?

22 (No response.)

23 CHAIRPERSON BENNETT: The ayes have it.

24 MS. BROWN: For the record, for the
25 first item of discussion, I'm sorry, I didn't get to
26 vote. I believe it was 3 to zero to adopt Order

1 Number 806?

2 CHAIRPERSON BENNETT: That's right.

3 MS. BROWN: Okay.

4 And for the second item, that would also
5 be 3 to zero to adopt the resolution?

6 CHAIRPERSON BENNETT: That's right.

7 MS. BROWN: Thank you.

8 CHAIRPERSON BENNETT: Do you have the
9 movers and the seconders?

10 MS. BROWN: Yes, I do.

11 CHAIRPERSON BENNETT: All right.

12 MS. BROWN: Thank you.

13 CHAIRPERSON BENNETT: All right. We
14 will now adjourn the Special Public Meeting.
