CHAIRPERSON CLARENS: Good evening, ladies and gentlemen. I'm Angel Clarens, Chairman of the Zoning Commission for the District of Columbia, and I declare this public hearing open.

The matter which is the subject of this hearing is Zoning Commission Case No. 99-3Z(II) which concerns itself with proposals offered by the law firm of Wilkes, Artis, Hedrick and Lane for the property at 1301 L Street, N.W. and the Downtown Housing Now Committee for the District's Department of Employment Services (DOES) site. This case involves text amendments to Chapter 17 (DD regulations) of the Zoning Regulations and is an offshoot of Case No. 99-3Z.

In a memorandum dated September 24, 1999, the Office of Planning has requested that tonight's public hearing be continued to Thursday, October 28, 1999. OP stated that sufficient resources have not been available to fully inform the record in this case due to an unusually large number of development projects that it is currently involved with. OP further indicated that both Wilkes, Artis, Hedrick and Lane and the Downtown Housing Now Committee have voiced no opposition to this request for a continuation.

Accordingly, as a procedural action, the Zoning Commission for the District of Columbia now adjourns tonight's public hearing to be continued to Thursday, October 28, 1999 at 7:00 p.m. in this hearing room.
