3 CHAIRPERSON REID: Good morning. We have a  
4 preliminary meeting this meeting of the Board of Zoning Adjustment,  
5 September 13, 1999, that we will take up prior to us commencing the  
6 hearing, which we apologize for the delay in the hearing starting on  
7 time this morning.

8 Ms. Pruitt-Williams?

9 MS. PRUITT: Good morning, Madam Chair.

10 Before you, you have a letter dated October 12<sup>th</sup>, in  
11 reference to case 16505. As you may remember, last week at your  
12 public meeting there was a request by both the Applicant and the  
13 Neighborhood Alliance to defer a decision on whether or not to  
14 postpone the hearing for the Mount Vernon College, G.W. Campus at  
15 Mt. Vernon, until this week. They are now asking — some type of  
16 understanding and hopefully come to resolution so there won't be any  
17 issues for you all.

18 CHAIRPERSON REID: All right.

19 MR. GILREATH: Madam Chairman, I feel that it's  
20 perfectly appropriate to give them the postponement, I think it's  
21 perfectly appropriate to give them another week, with the possibility  
22 that they  
23 may resolve the conflict and difficulty.

24 So, do you want me to make a motion to that effect?

25 CHAIRPERSON REID: Sure.

26 MR. GILREATH: I make a motion we defer this for —

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1 one week is adequate?

2 MS. PRUITT: That's what they are requesting.

3 MR. GILREATH: Okay, one week.

4 CHAIRPERSON REID: Okay. I second it.

5 All in favor?

6 (Ayes.)

7 CHAIRPERSON REID: Opposed?

8 MS. PRUITT: Staff will record the vote as 3/0 to defer  
9 this action until next week.

10 CHAIRPERSON REID: Okay.

11 Ms. Pruitt-Williams?

12 MS. PRUITT: That concludes staff's — that concludes  
13 staff's issues for this meeting. You can adjourn the hearing.

14 CHAIRPERSON REID: The meeting will be adjourned  
15 for September 13, 1999.
